COMPANY HISTORY

Brother and sister Graeme and Gill Riley started their plant hire business GGR Glass Services in Rochdale, Greater Manchester, in 1995 with just four employees and four glass lifting machines in their fleet. In 1997, Graeme and Gill travelled to the USA to secure an exclusive UK dealership for Woods Powr-Grip, the world's leading manufacturer of glass vacuum lifting equipment.

In 2001, GGR became an early adopter of mini spider cranes and secured a dealership with Japanese manufacturer Furukawa UNIC to import UNIC mini cranes into the UK. After adding ten cranes to their hire fleet, these machines were soon in high demand, transforming GGR into an 'overnight' success. Gill and Graeme saw the potential to expand the mini crane concept into Europe and then successfully secured a European Master dealership with manufacturer Furukawa UNIC. GGR sold its first mini crane in 2003 and celebrated the sale of its 200th mini crane in 2006. Today there are over 150 spider cranes in GGR's hire fleet.

GGR were also the first company to help develop and provide industry-recognised qualifications for mini spider crane and vacuum lifter operation in the UK at our own training facilities. Find out more about our training courses <u>here</u>.
